

## University of Texas Uniform Group Insurance Program Required Documentation for Eligible Dependents

Dependent	Relationship Code	Required Documents (All required documents, except as noted with "**", must be issued by a legitimate governmental authority)
<b>Spouse</b>	04	<p><u>One</u> of the following documents:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A valid marriage certificate between subscriber and spouse; OR</li> <li>• A declaration of informal marriage certified by a Texas County Clerk; OR</li> <li>• A valid declaration of informal marriage certified in another state; OR</li> <li>• Other documentation deemed acceptable by OEB</li> </ul>
<b>Biological Child</b>	05	<p><u>One</u> of the following documents:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A Birth Certificate of Child proving relationship to Subscriber; OR</li> <li>• A Certification of Vital Records proving relationship to Subscriber; OR</li> <li>• A Verification of Birth Facts Form* proving relationship to Subscriber; OR</li> <li>• A valid Medical Support Order requiring Subscriber to provide medical coverage; OR</li> <li>• Paternity test* accompanied by Court Order, Medical Support Order, or reissued Birth Certificate</li> </ul>
<b>Adopted Child</b>	09	<p><u>One</u> of the following documents:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A valid Court Order of Adoption; OR</li> <li>• A valid Pre-Adoption Placement Order issued by a Licensed Child Placement Agency; OR</li> <li>• A valid Court Order naming Subscriber as Managing Conservator of Child; OR</li> <li>• A Birth Certificate of Child with Adoptive Parent(s); OR</li> <li>• A valid Medical Support Order requiring Subscriber to provide medical coverage</li> </ul>
<b>Stepchild</b>	17	<p><u>All</u> of the following documents:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A Birth Certificate of Child; AND</li> <li>• A Marriage Certificate of Subscriber and Spouse (Biological Parent)</li> </ul>
<b>Foster Child</b>	08	<p>The following document:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A valid Court Order establishing a parent-child relationship between Subscriber and Foster Child</li> </ul>

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<b>Grandchild</b>	23	<p><u>All</u> of the following documents:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A Birth Certificate of Grandchild or Verification of Birth Facts Form* proving relationship to Subscriber; AND</li> <li>• A Birth Certificate of Biological Parent; AND</li> <li>• A Grandchild Certification Form*; AND</li> <li>• The most recent tax return indicating grandchild is the financial dependent of Subscriber</li> </ul>
<b>Incapacitated Over Age Dependent</b>	07	<p><u>All</u> of the following documents:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A valid Document (e.g., birth certificate, adoption papers) proving relationship to Subscriber; AND</li> <li>• An Application For Coverage of Incapacitated Over Age Dependent Form*; AND</li> <li>• Supporting Medical Records less than one-year old*; AND</li> <li>• The most recent tax return indicating Over Age Dependent is the financial dependent of Subscriber</li> </ul>
<b>Ward</b>	15	<p>The following document:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A valid Court Order naming Subscriber as Guardian or Conservator</li> </ul>

- \*Important:*
1. A Power of Attorney is not adequate legal documentation for establishing a Dependent relationship.
  2. A complete copy (all pages) of a Court Order may be required to be provided, depending on eligibility and documentation requirements.
  3. If Subscriber is unable to provide the above document(s) but has other documentation that may establish a Dependent relationship, the institution HR Manager should review and determine whether the alternative documentation is adequate.
  4. A document in a language other than English must be accompanied by a notarized, sworn affidavit by an independent third party indicating the document has been reviewed and translated.
