

**Contract Threshold for Board of Regents' Approval and  
Office of General Counsel (OGC) Review  
August 1, 2023**

Regents' Rule 10501, Sec. 2.2.17, provides authority to OGC to increase the Board approval threshold and to designate [Special Procedures Contracts](#), which procedures still apply. Requests for exceptions to the Special Procedures can be submitted to OGC.
