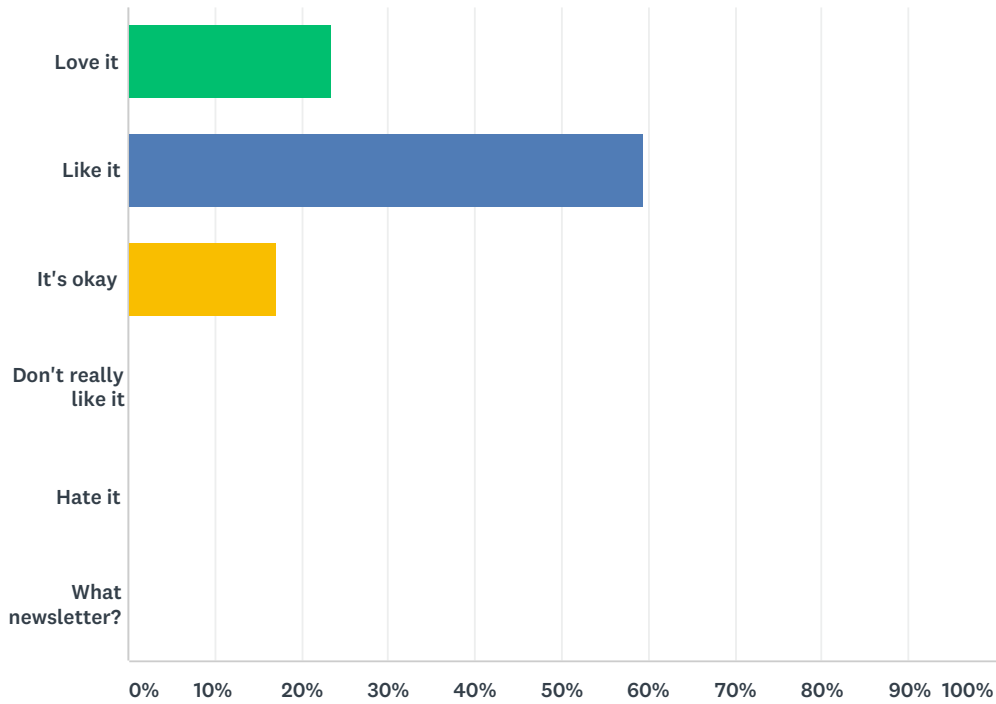


Q1 What is your overall satisfaction with the newsletter?

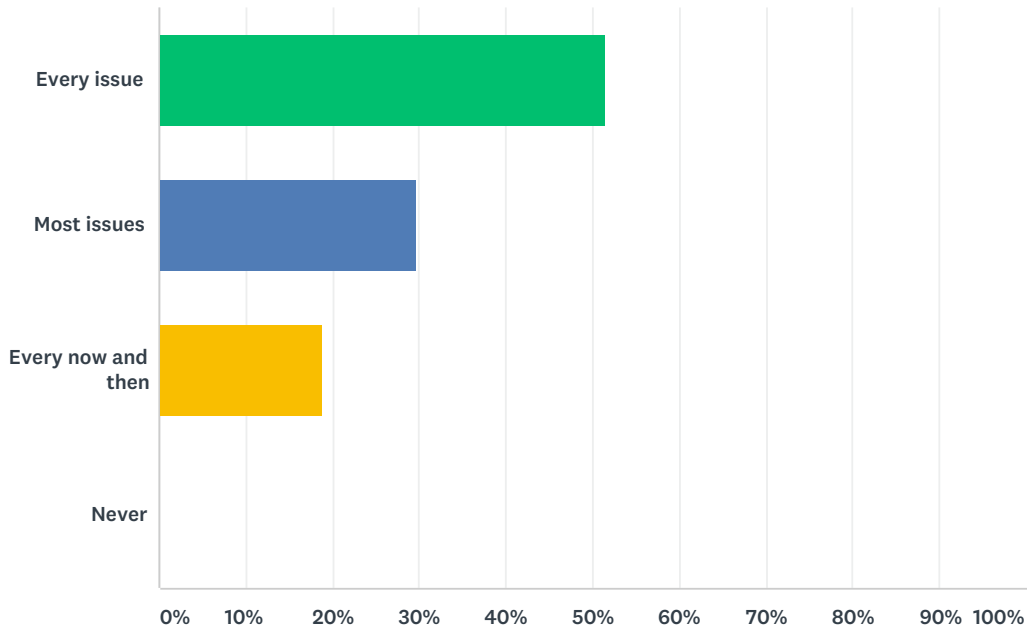

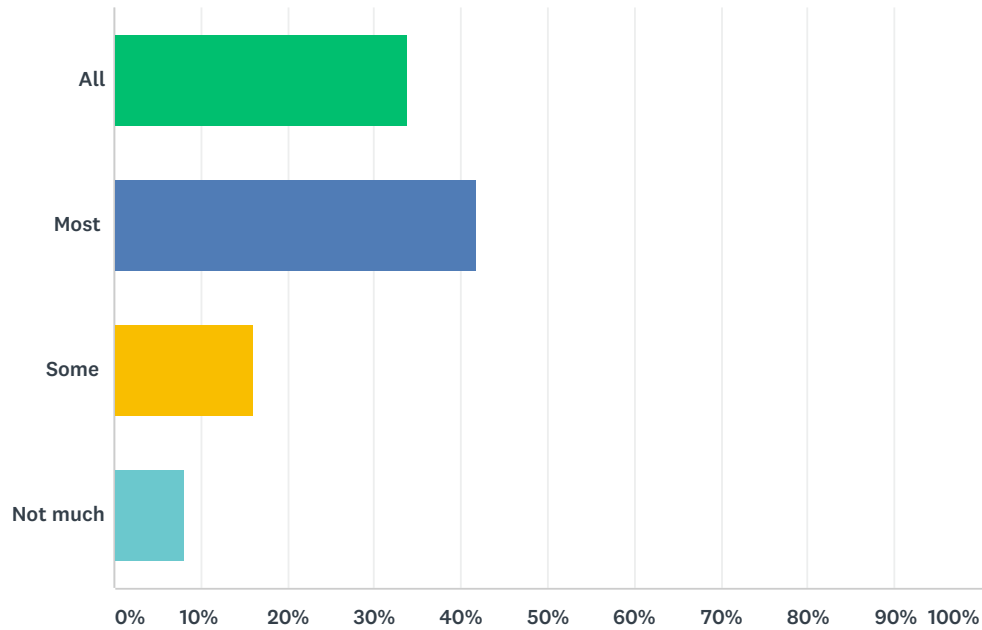

Q3 How much of the newsletter do you usually read?

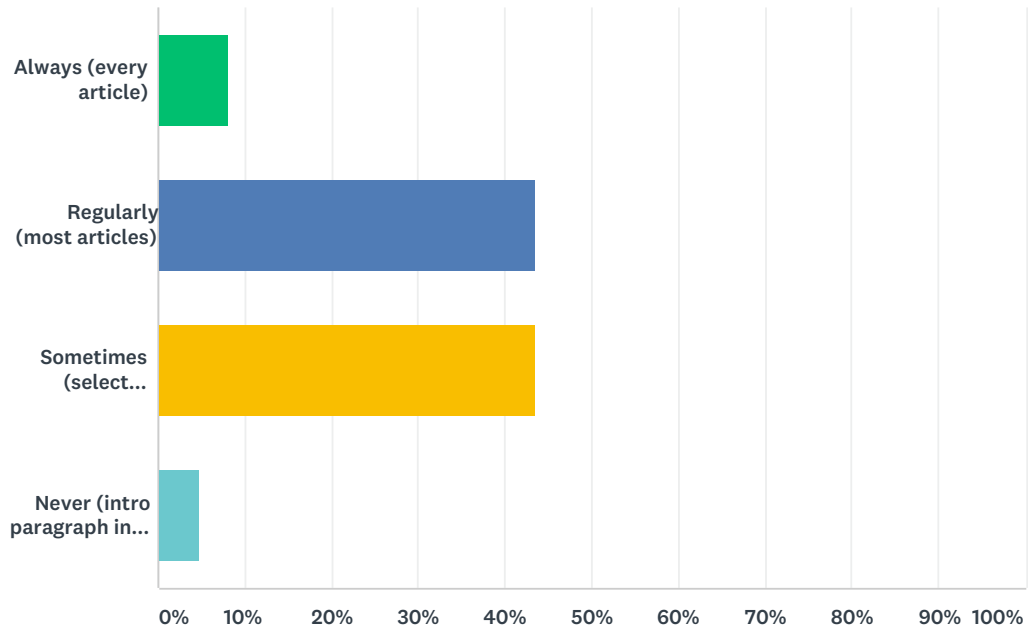

Q4 How often do you click the "read more" to get the entire story?

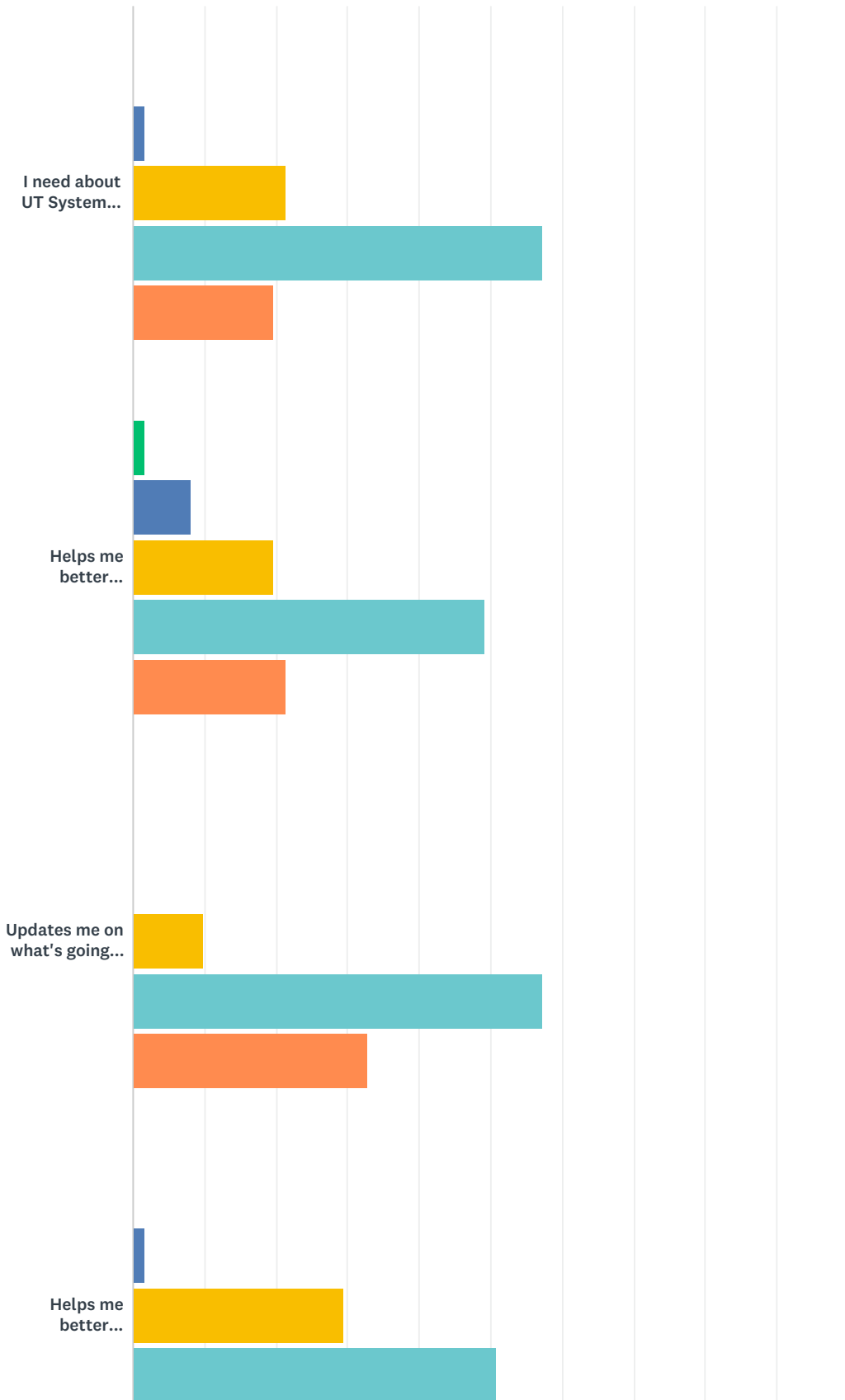

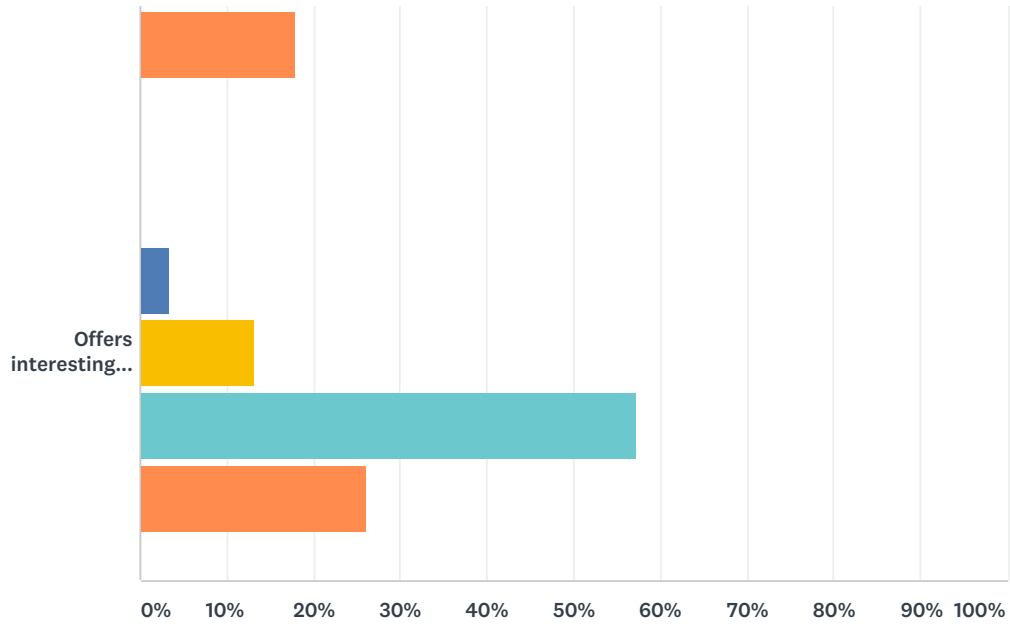

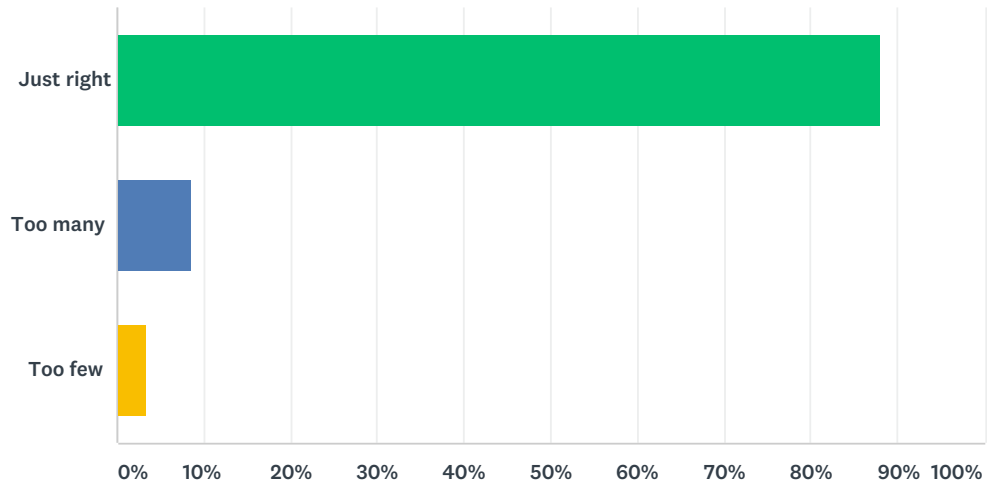

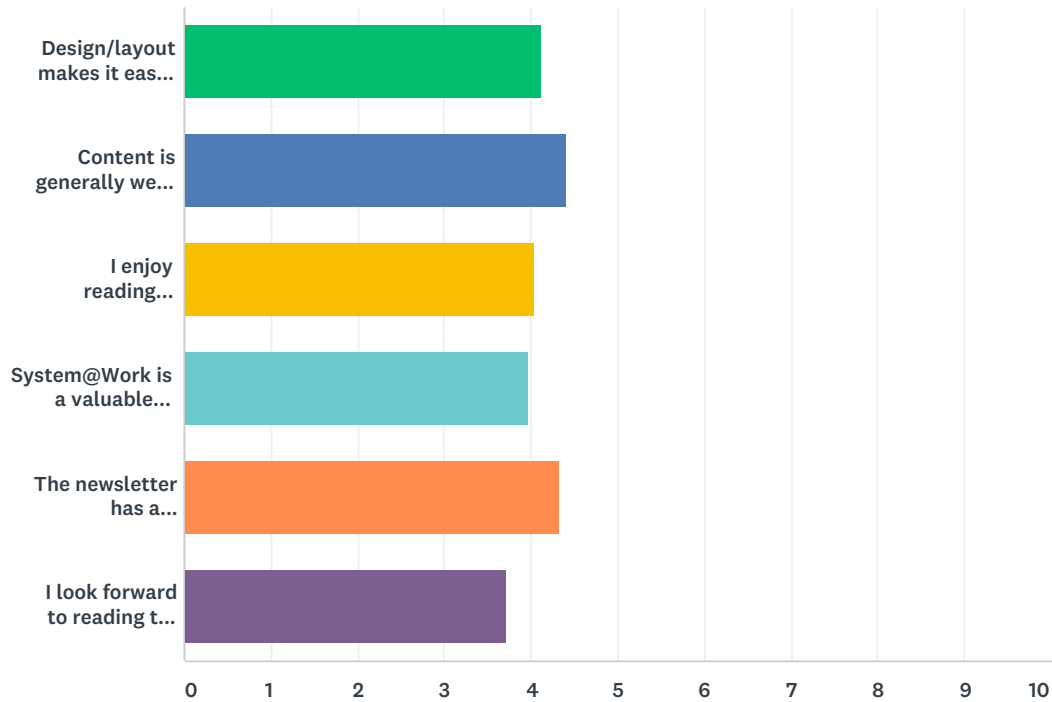
