PUMPKIN CARVING CONTEST AND AUCTION RULES:

- One entry per department. Multiple entries from one department will be included in the silent auction, but only one will be judged. Departments should coordinate on which pumpkin they want to be judged.
- All entries for the pumpkin-carving contest must be brought to Room 2.206, 9:30-10:30 a.m. on October 31st.
- Judging for the pumpkin-carving contests will take place before the main event. Winners will be announced during the social event.
- Prizes will be awarded in the following categories: Crowd Favorite; Most Creative; Highest Auction bid.

PUMPKIN AUCTION: (DON'T FORGET CASH OR CHECKBOOK)

- Pumpkins will be auctioned off to benefit the United Way. Pumpkins will be auctioned as is, including all lighting sources and other props or decorations.
- A light source for the pumpkins must be provided, but there will be no electrical outlet access.
- If you bid on the pumpkin auction, you will need to bring a check or cash when you pick up your pumpkin, by 3pm on October 31st.

BAKING CONTEST AND AUCTION RULES:



- Each baker will need to provide enough samples for 8 tastings for the judges, as well as standard sized dessert to be auctioned to benefit the SECC.
- Submissions will be judged on taste, appearance, and overall presentation. Judging for the baking contest will take place before the main event.
- All entries for the baking and pumpkin-carving contest entries must be brought to **Room 2.206, between 9:30-10:30 a.m. on October 31st.**
